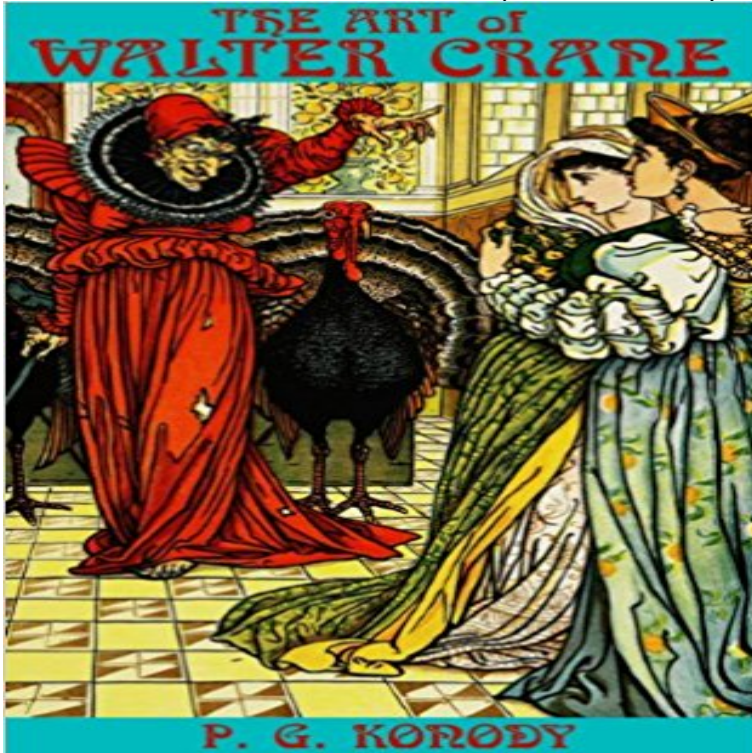


The Art of Walter Crane (Illustrated)
