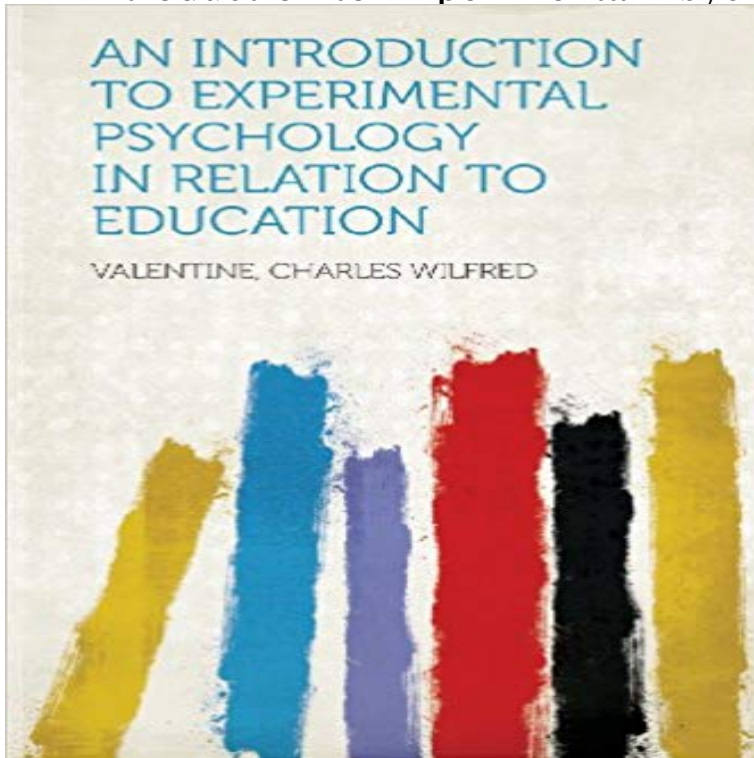


# An Introduction to Experimental Psychology in Relation to Education
