
Understanding Aggressive Behavior in Children (Annals of the New York Academy of Sciences)

Counseling has significant effect on hyperactive children, leaving drug therapy as the best hope. Children who are victims of abuse and neglect and later become violent adults undergo detectable changes in brain chemistry.
