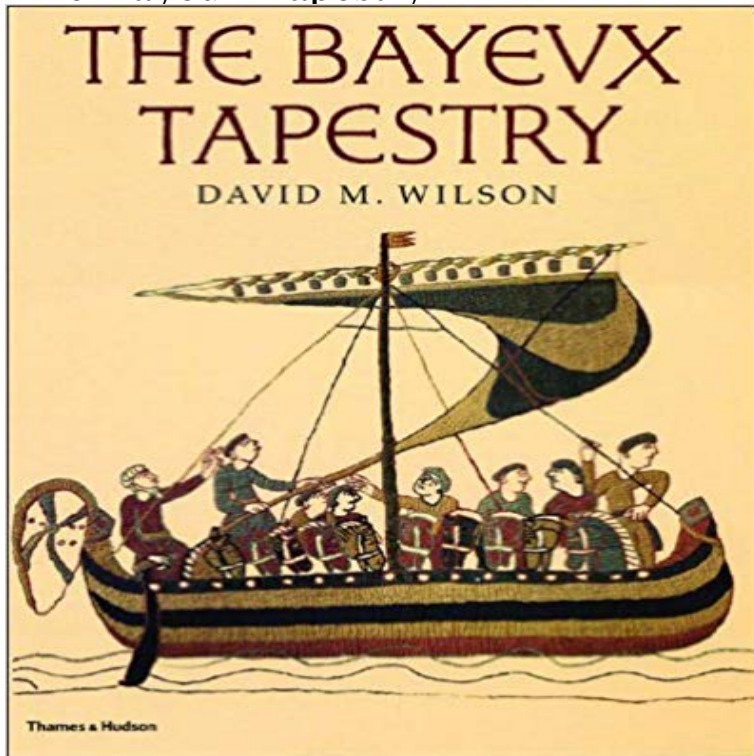


The Bayeux Tapestry
