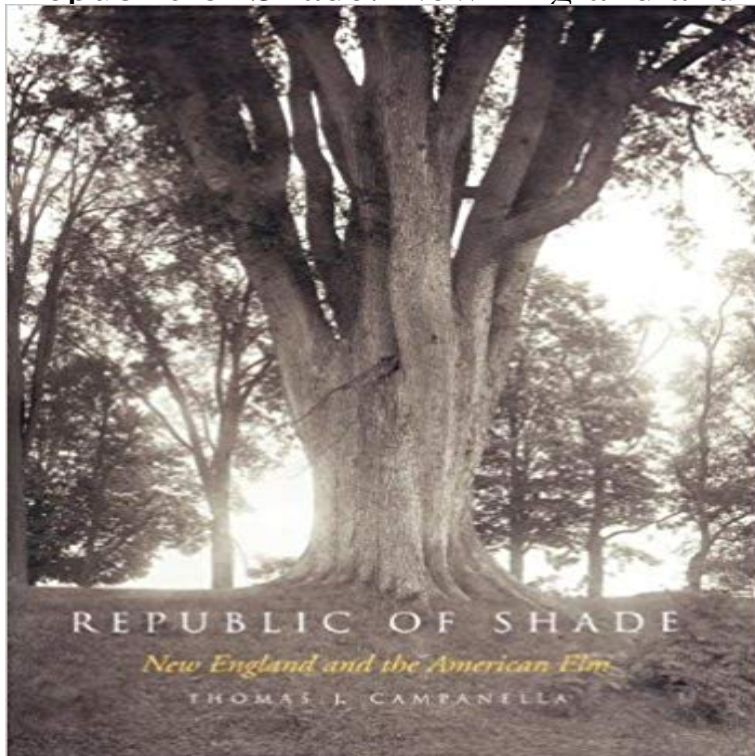


Republic of Shade: New England and the American Elm
