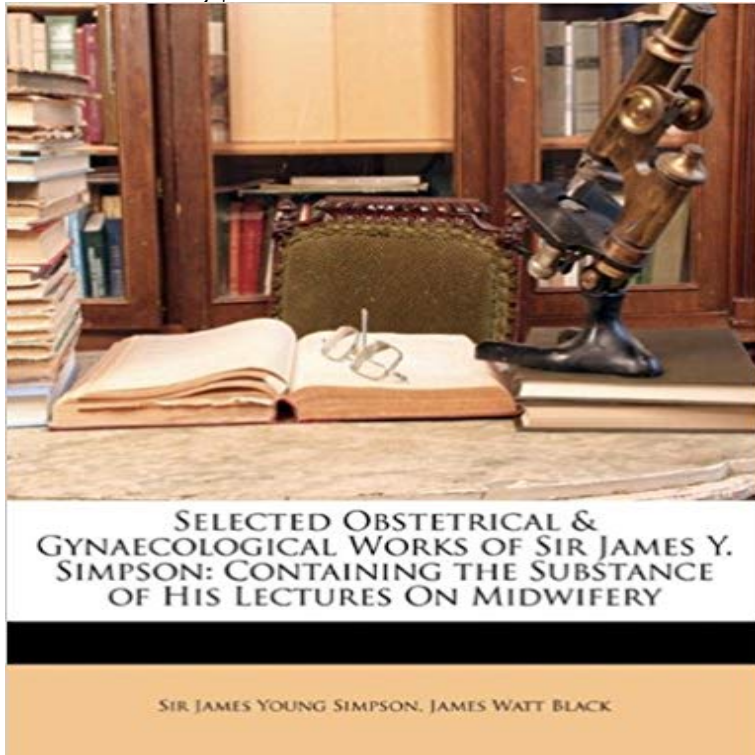


## Selected Obstetrical & Gynaecological Works of Sir James Y. Simpson: Containing the Substance of His Lectures On Midwifery
