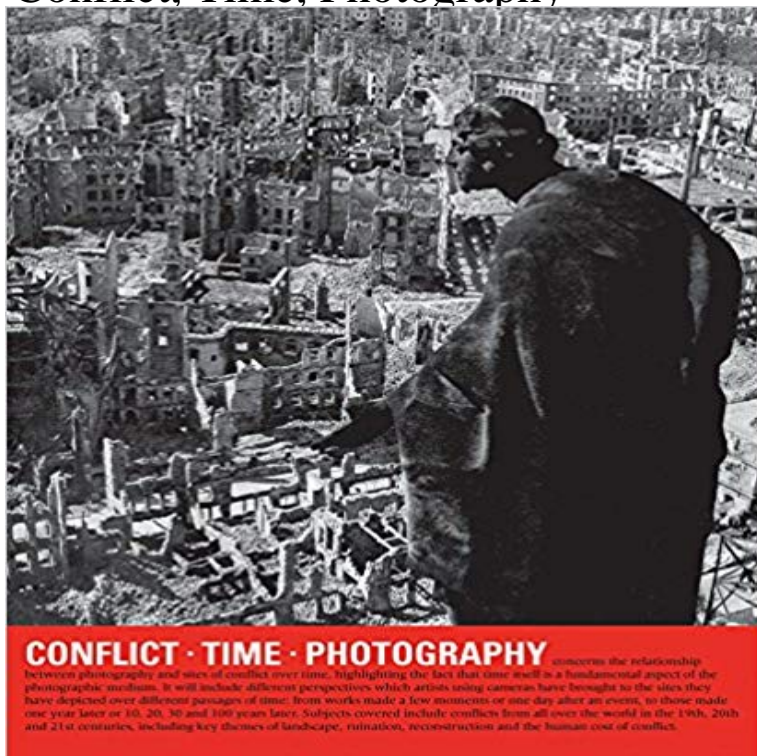


Conflict, Time, Photography
