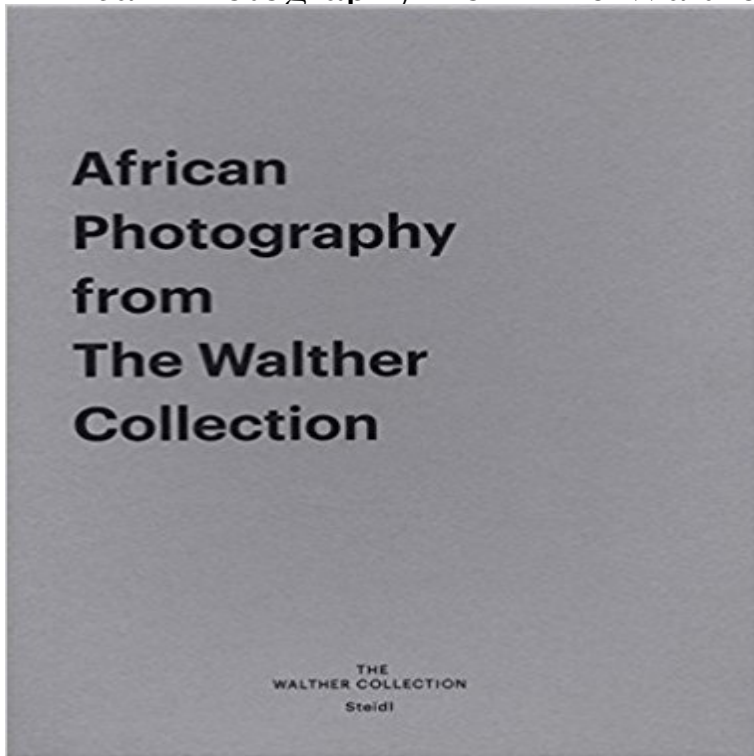


African Photography from The Walther Collection
