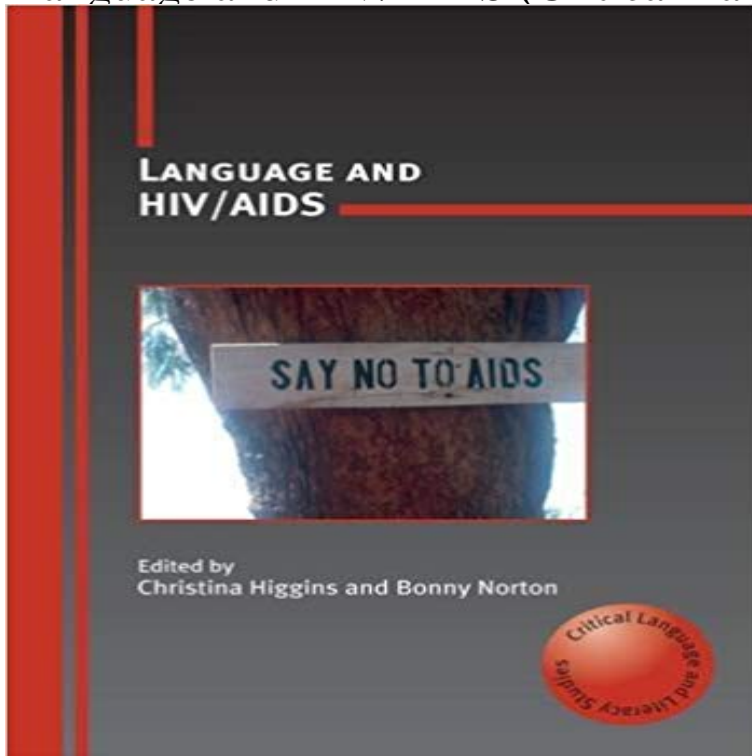


## Language and HIV/AIDS (Critical Language and Literacy Studies)
