

America, 1 to lj ft. high, with lanceshaped leaves in whorls, and sombre wine-purple coloured flowers. P. latifolia .-- A variable Caucasian Fritillary about 1 ft. high, with drooping flowers varying in colour through various shades of purple, black, lilac, and yellow.
