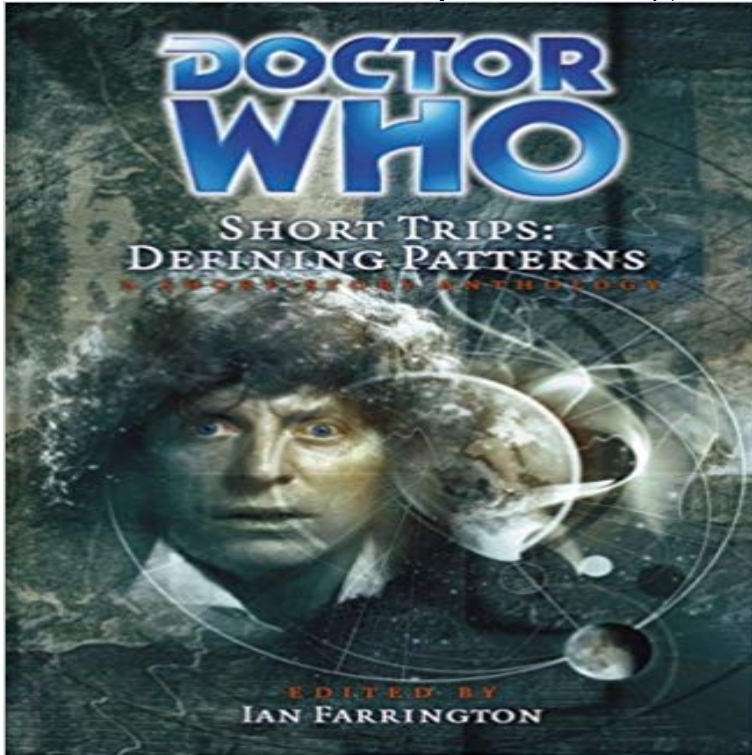


Doctor Who Short Trips: Defining Patterns
