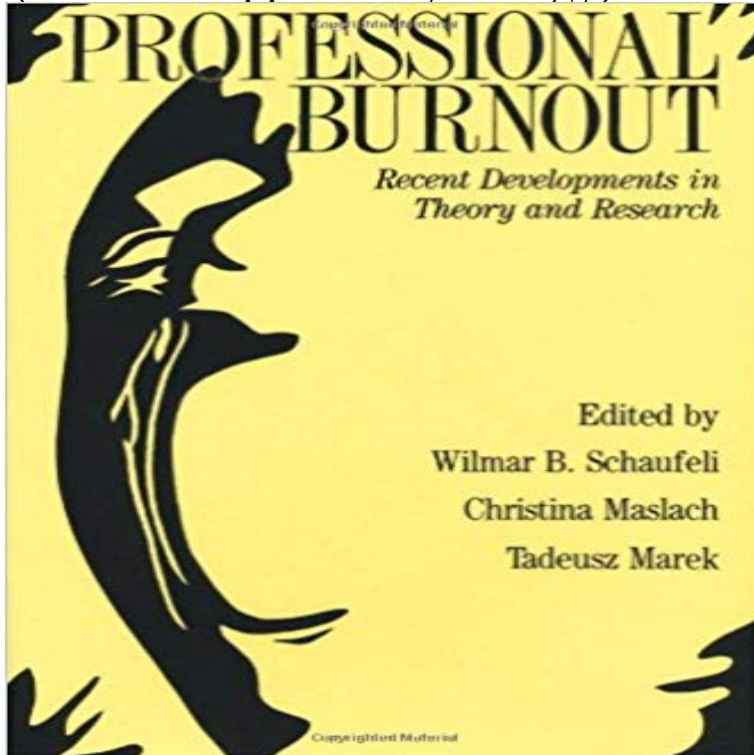


Professional Burnout: Recent Developments In Theory And Research (Series in Applied Psychology)

Written by an international group of leading scholars, the papers are divided into five sections: interpersonal approaches, individual approaches, organizational approaches, methodological issues, and the future outlook of burnout. This book expands on the First European Conference on Professional Burnout, held in Krakow, Poland, in 1990.
