

Low blood sugar can happen in people with diabetes who take medicines that increase insulin levels in the body. Taking too much medication, skipping meals, eating less than normal, or exercising more than usual can lead to low blood sugar. Blood sugar is also known as glucose. Without enough glucose, your body cannot perform its normal functions. Your blood sugar is considered low when it drops below 70 mg/dL. Immediate treatment for low blood sugar levels is important.
