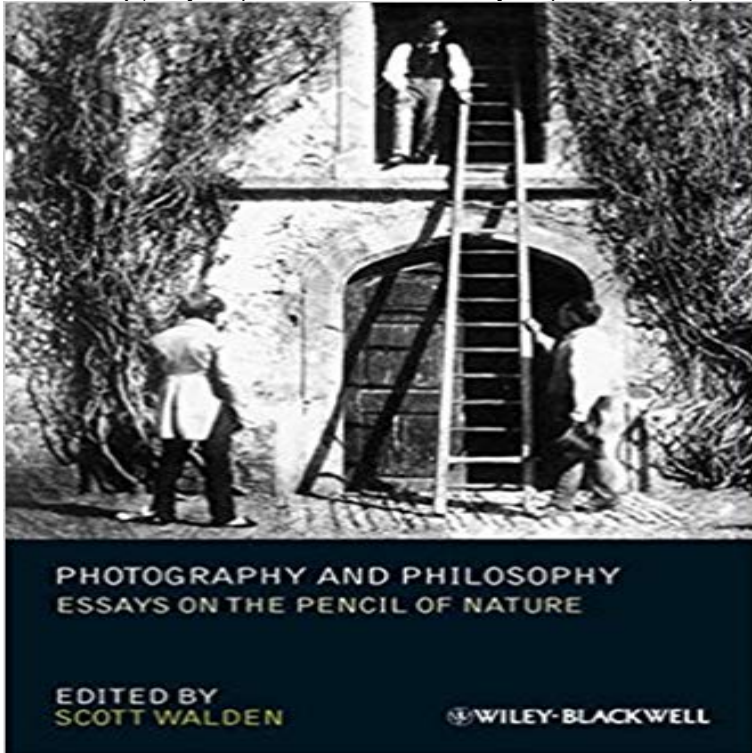


Photography and Philosophy: Essays on the Pencil of Nature
