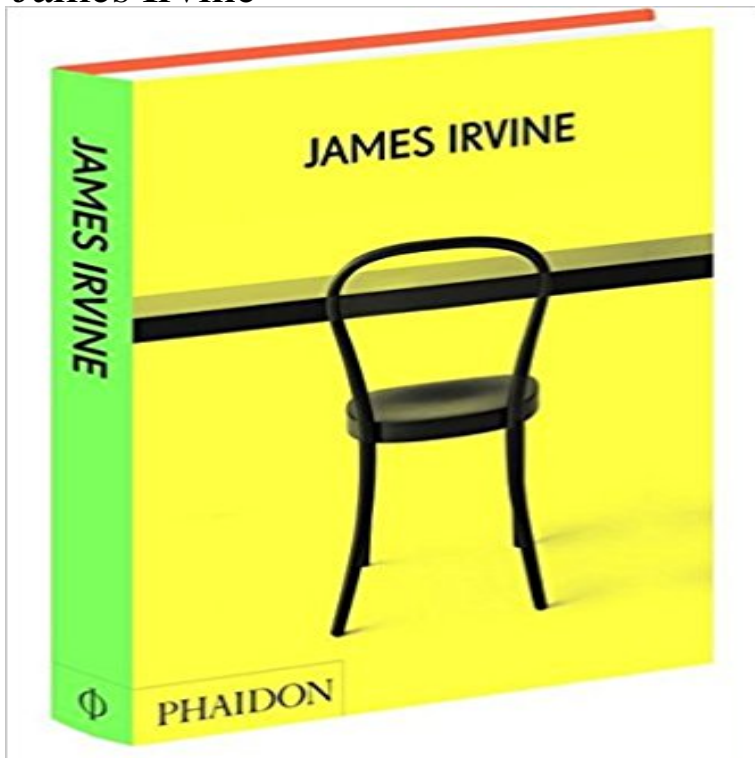


# James Irvine
