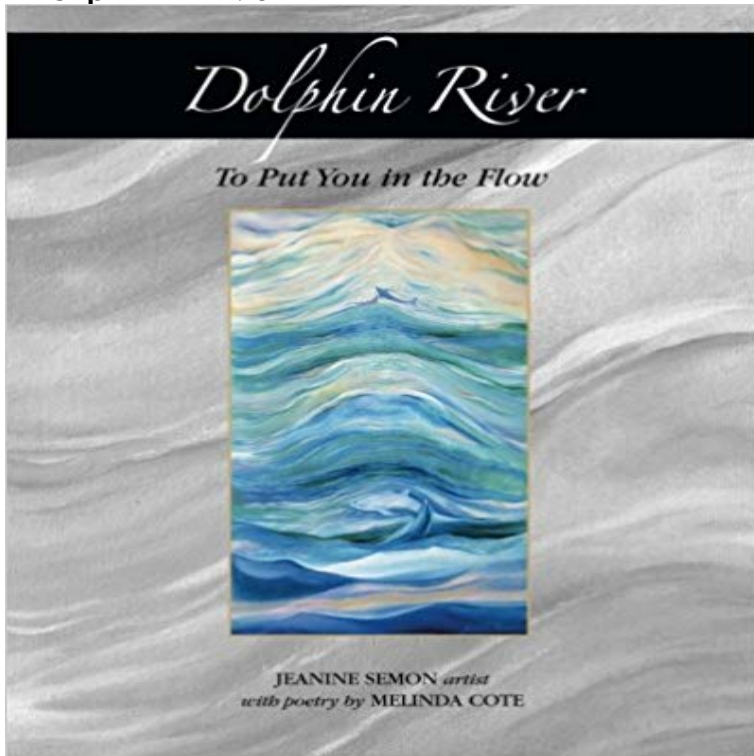


Dolphin River
