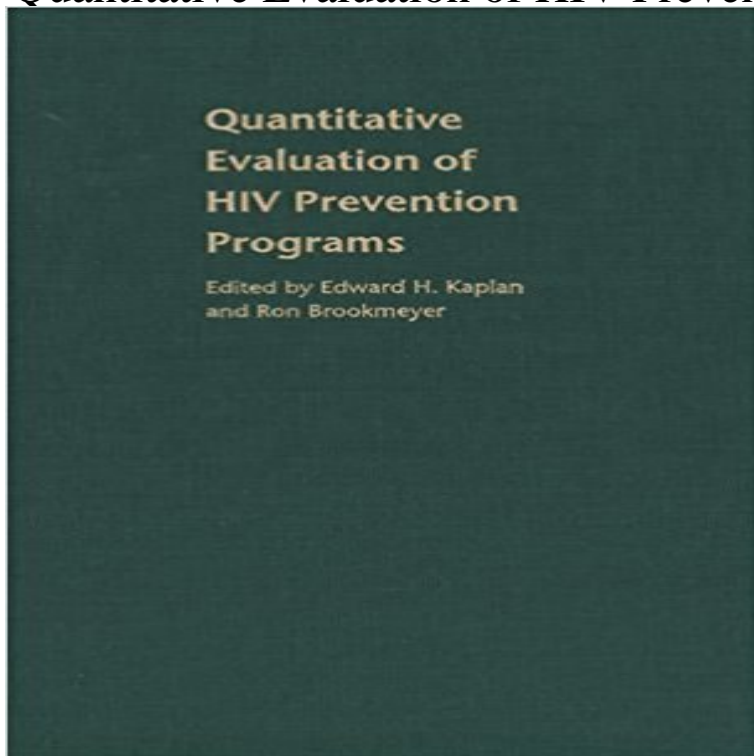


Quantitative Evaluation of HIV Prevention Programs
