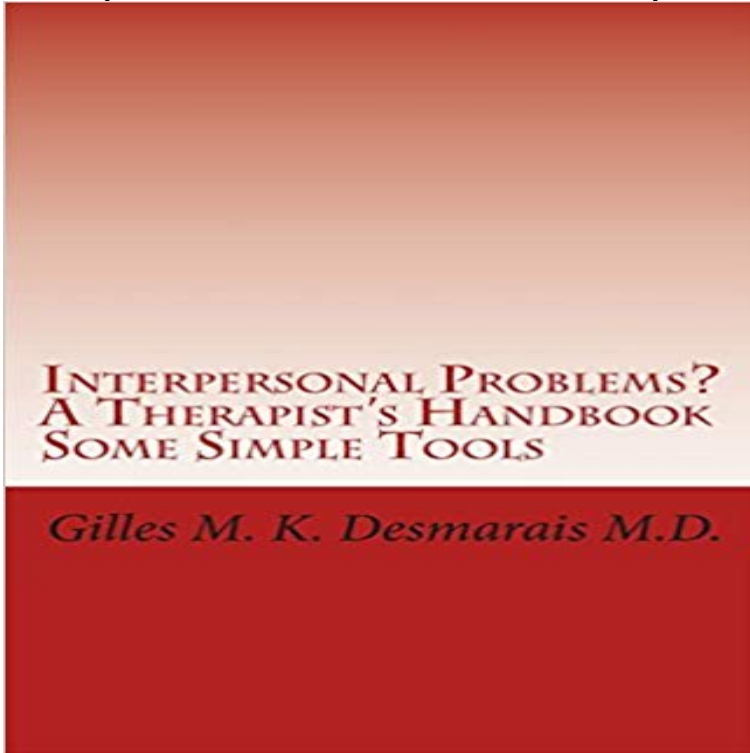


Interpersonal Problems? A Therapists Handbook Some Simple Tools
