
Ready-Aim-Fire Problem Solving: A Strategic Approach to Decision Making

So that we do not fall into the same trap as the losers to e-business, both as organizations and individuals, we need to be aware of the routines that we have developed. We need to understand the preferences that we have for solving problems and making decisions and for how we approach situations. We need to use a problem solving approach that values routines and past experiences whilst scanning the current and future environment for opportunities alternatives. We need to develop our skills and abilities to utilize the processes and people that we interact with to the best advantage.
