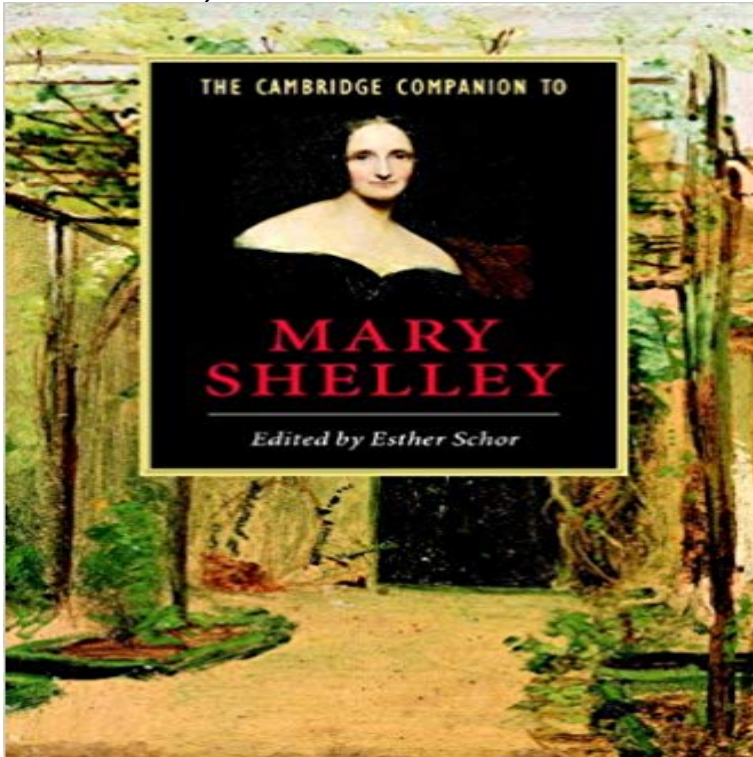


The Cambridge Companion to Mary Shelley (Cambridge Companions to Literature)
