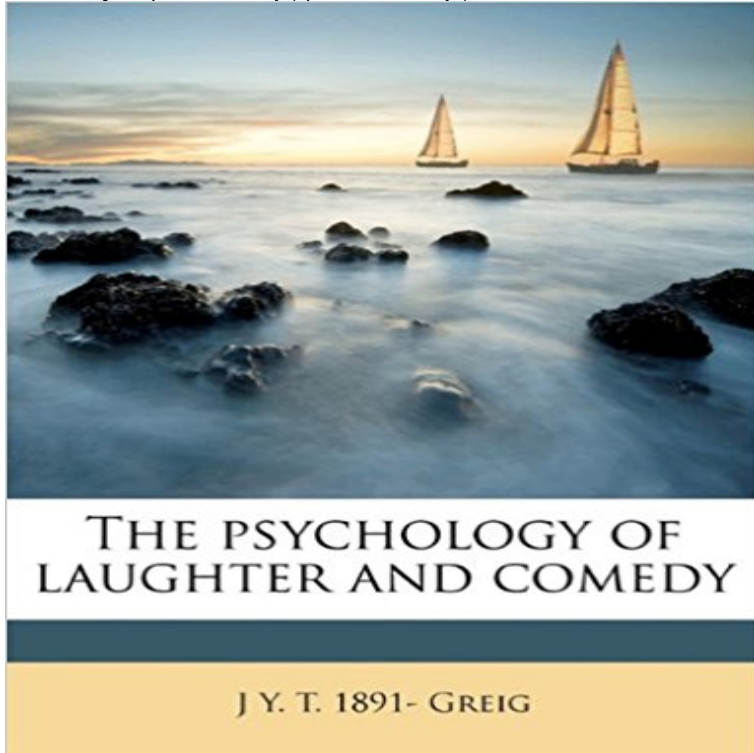


## The psychology of laughter and comedy
