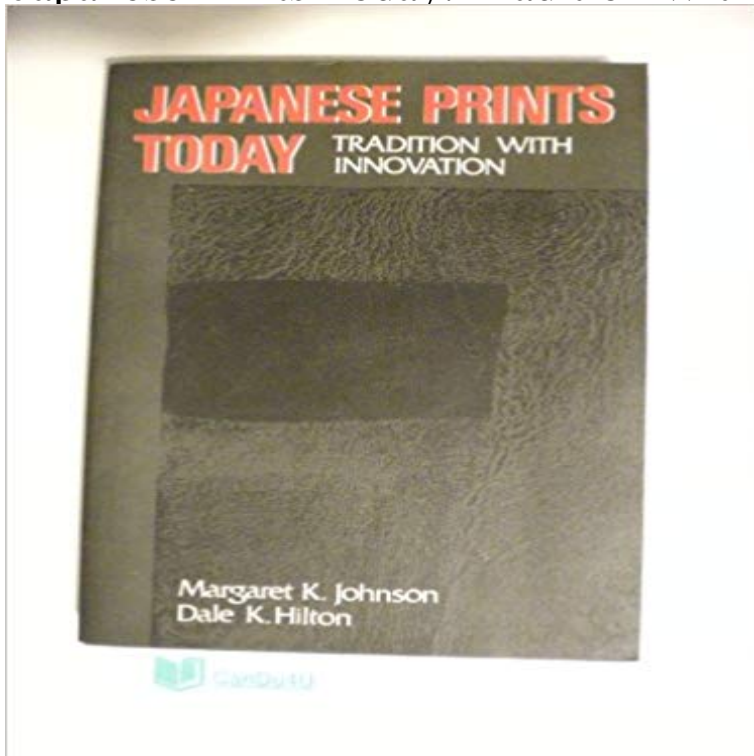


Japanese Prints Today: Tradition With Innovation
