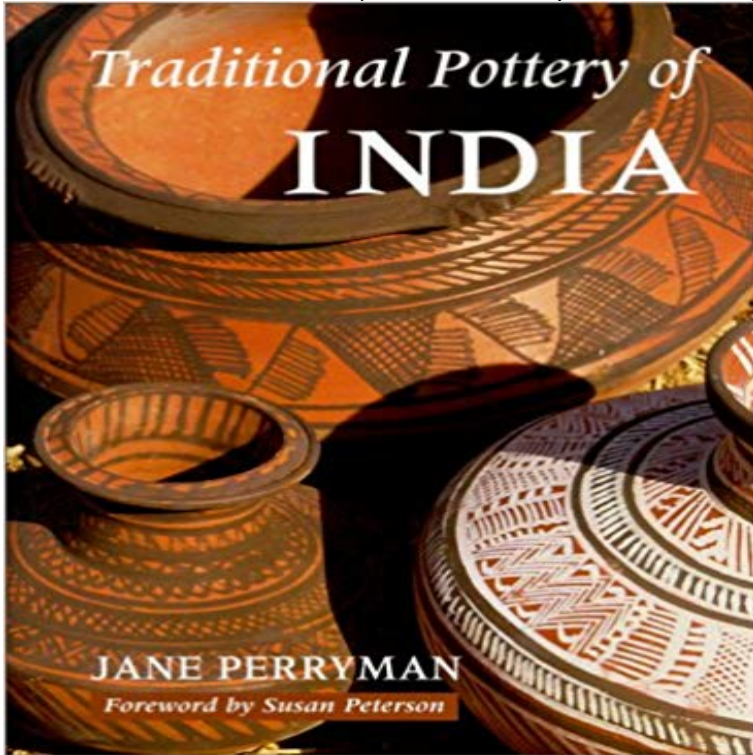


Traditional Pottery of India (Ceramics)
