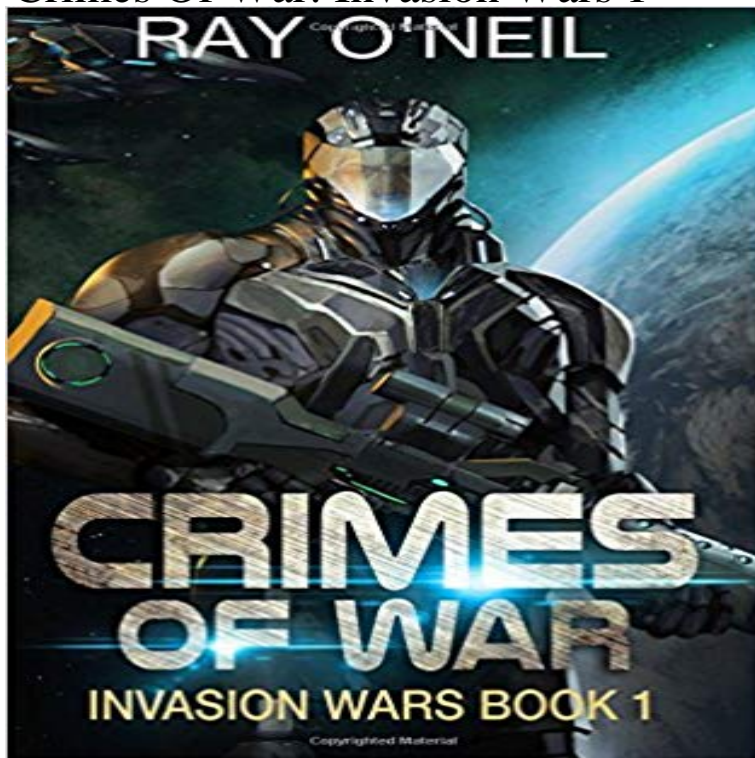


Crimes Of War: Invasion Wars 1
