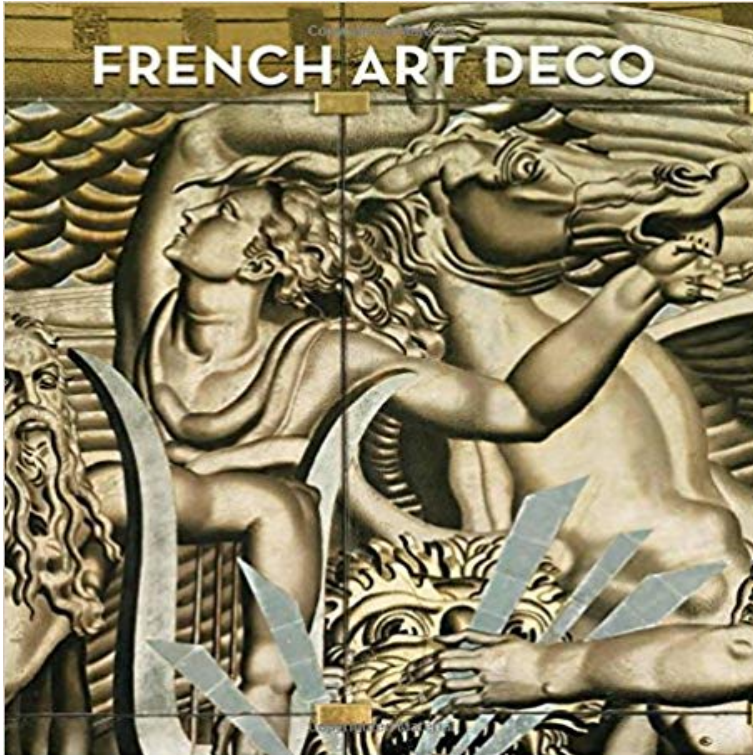


## French Art Deco
