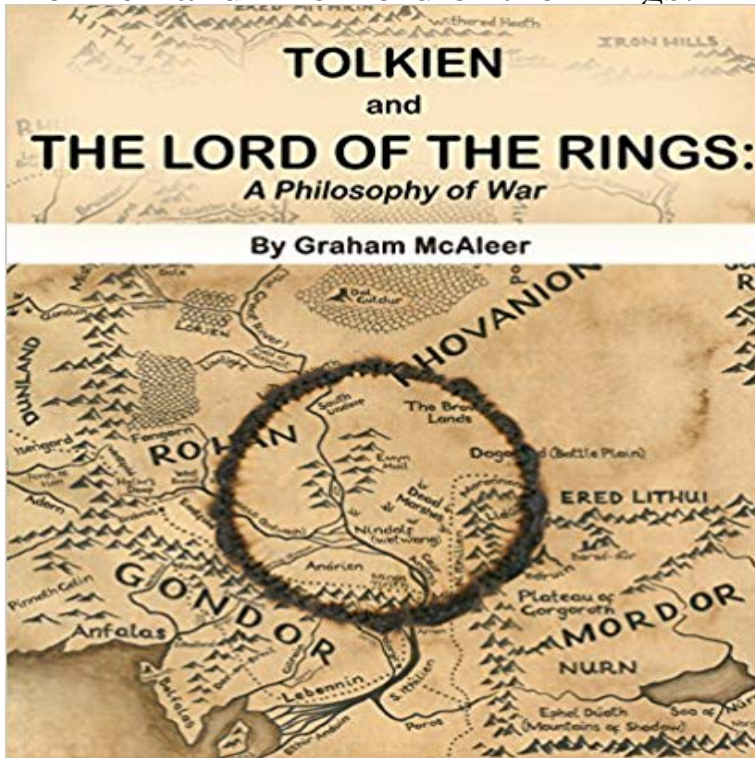


Tolkien and The Lord of the Rings: A Philosophy of War
