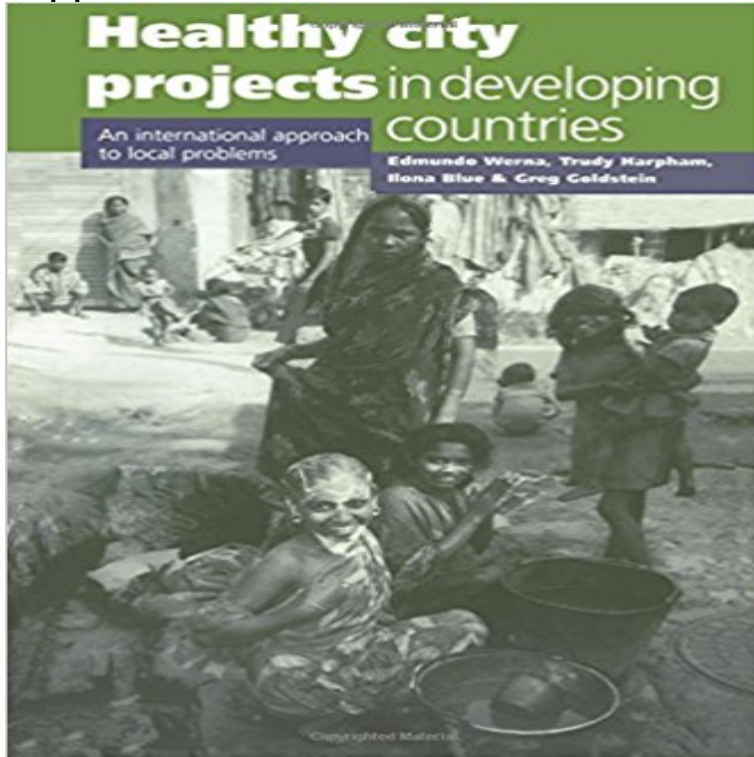


Healthy City Projects in Developing Countries: An International Approach to Local Problems
